REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

June 19, 2025

Chairman Isaacson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm

Phil Tiderman was present to discuss the dust on Carlson Road due to the gravel hauling from the gravel pit. At the present time the situation is under control as the Chloride has been applied by the Tiderman home and Garrett Dahlen stated that he maintains a slow speed near the two homes near the road.
