REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

July 17, 2025

PRESENT- Supervisors Dave Isaacson, J, Earl Nett, Treasurer Naomi Mowers, and Town Clerk Mark Carlson.

Chairman Isaacson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm

Phil Tiderman was present to discuss future years' major hauling of gravel from the Rybak gravel pit and how the dust control measures could be addressed. The Board discussed various options and will continue to work toward a solution.

The minutes of the June 19, 2025 regular meeting were read. Nett moved and Isaacson seconded to approve the minutes

Treasurer Mowers reported that the first half tax funds had been received and are included in the fund balances.

The Board reviewed the MN DOT Silver Township map. Isaacson moved, Nett seconded to approve the map with corrections and for it to be submitted to the MN DOT.

Naomi Mowers reviewed initial research on creating a township website which had been directed by the citizens at the March Annual meeting. After discussion it was decided that the township would contact Bobby Dorman to attend a township meeting to discuss costs and options.

Isaacson reported that Hurst Contracting will begin installing culverts in late August.

Nett reported on a call received from Kalevala Township and Rex Lowe regarding the roadway/easement that runs through Lowe's property. The Board reaffirmed that it is not a Silver Township road and that Kalevala has an easement through the property. Any dispute is between Kalevala Township and the property owner Rex Lowe. Nett will report back to Kalevala Township.

With the initial township gravel hauling being completed, the supervisors will check the roads to see if there are other spots that need gravel.

Isaacson will be meeting with a representative from Lake Country Power to find a solution to the power line running alongside Walczak road which has a pole that may need to be moved to allow an improvement to Walczak road to be completed.

With no further business, Isaacson moved and Nett seconded to adjourn the meeting
