Chairman Isaacson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm

The minutes of the August 21,2025 regular meeting were read. Nett moved and Isaacson seconded to approve the minutes.

Motion by Isaacson, seconded by Nett to authorize Naomi Mowers to make decisions for the township working needed by Bob Dorman as the new website is created.

A motion by Isaacson and seconded by Nett to approve the cost quotes by 218-TEK for the website of \$2500 for construction and \$425 annual maintenance of the website and also pay \$625 down toward the project.

Isaacson reported that he will be meeting with Hurst Construction regarding the culvert installations in the next couple of weeks.

Isaacson reported that the gravel hauling by Garrett Dahlen is completed this week. 33 additional loads were hauled.

Isaacson met with Eric Labounty regarding the utility pole on Walczak Road and how the township could expand the width of the road. There will probably be no work done until next year.

Isaacson will contact Carlton County sign crew to install missing signs on Gary Anderson Road and Wojtisiak Road. Carlton County has ordered Narrow Road signs for Walczak Road and expect to receive them in six weeks

Isaacson reported that Grimm would be talking to the County road grader operator regarding reclaiming gravel from the edge of the roads.

With no further business, Isaacson moved and Nett seconded to adjourn the meeting
