Garrett Dahlen will check out the site and see if the ditching is something he could do for the township and report back to Isaacson.

The beaver problem near the Brown Road was discussed. Nett will discuss with the local game warden for options.

Starting in November, the regular meetings will change to starting at 6pm for the winter months.
