Currently the Board of Supervisors are trained for the next Board of Equalization but will need to complete training prior to 2027.

Corey Hurst was in attendance and discussed the culvert installation. He recommended that the board consider using full length pipes for all installations as it seems culverts degrade first wherever there is a band.

Gravel hauling for the year has been completed.
