The Board signed the Gravel contract with Rydberg& Sons.

The Board discussed the installation of culverts. Chairman Isaacson will contact a few local contractors and obtain at least two quotes for the board to consider at the July meeting.

The Board also discussed the financial situation of the township with the costs of completing the work that is being expected. Decisions on the amount of work will be made after the receiving of the 1st half taxes.
