BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULAR MEETING
July 16, 2026

Chairman Isaacson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

The minutes of the June 18, 2026 meeting were read and approved on motion by Grimm and seconded by Isaacson

The first half tax revenue has been received which increases fund balances and increased the current checkbook balance to \$114,213.76

Isaacson will contact Carlton County to replace the missing North Birch Road sign by Highway 73 and ask them to replace the Dead end sign on Carlson Road that appears to be have knocked down during the County's brush cutting.

Tollefson Excavating- \$17,875

Hurst Contracting- \$16,500

Grimm moved to accept the Hurst Contracting quote of \$16,500.

The Board appointed the following election judges for the 2026 Primary and General Elections. They are Mark Carlson, Jean Hedin, Brenda Heikkila, Don Heying, Russell Peterson, and Robin Young.

The 2025 State Demographer reported that the estimated population for Silver Township is 451 and the number of households is 174.

There is a Zoning meeting for a variance on County Rd 132 on Tuesday July 21st at 4pm. Isaacson plans on attending.

Nett arrived at the meeting and reported that there is a meeting on Tuesday, July 21st at 6pm being held to discuss the local fire department situation and possible fire districts.
